HISTORIC RALLY TROPHY 2021 REGULATIONS (HRT)

1. General

Historic Rally Trophy 2021 is an official Finnish ASN (AKK-Motorsport) series and the series follows the National Regulations for Motorsports, general Rally Regulations, these series rules, Historic Regularity Rally (HTRS) regulations, Classic F Series regulations or any amendments and bulletins. In the case of a conflict, these series regulations and the Historic Regularity Rally regulations will be interpreted by the Historic Rally Club Finland board.

In the series it will be competed for the Historic Rally Trophy victory in the following categories:

- Historic Group 1
- Historic -69
- Historic -75
- Historic -81
- Historic -90

as well as in the following classes;

- Reconnaissance Class (NS)
- Classic F
- Historic Regularity Rally (HTRS)

The rallies also have a Historic Show Run class (HN).

Historic Rally Trophy and Classic F series are open to competitors holding a national or international competitor's license issued by the ASN. Both crew members must be 18 years of age or older.

Foreign competitors can also participate in the Historic Rally Trophy series (classes 1-24; HRT and HTRS) and collect points with a license issued by a foreign motorsport association. However, participation in a license issued by a foreign rally association is conditional on that license entitling you to compete in foreign rallies.

You can also participate in the HTRS classes and the HN class with a familiarisation license; in HTRS in addition to the Autoliitto (AL) license, and then no rally license degree is required of a competitor.

2. Historic Rally Trophy series cars and classes

- Class 1 – 23; participating cars must have a FIA HTP, or an old passport (expired FIA HTP issued on 10/2007 or later).
- Cars participating in Historic Regularity Rally (HTRS) series (class 24) may alternatively have either a FIA HTP, or an old passport (expired FIA HTP issued on 10/2007 or later), HRCP or FIVA IC.
- Cars participating in the Historic Show Run (HN; class 25) must have a valid FIA HTP, an old passport (expired FIA HTP issued on 10/2007 or later) or a Historic Show Run (HN) passport.
- Classic F (class 26 - 28); cars complying with Classic F technical homologations

4. Registration for the series

No separate registration is required for the series.

5. Fees

There is no separate serial registration fee for the series. The organizers of the competitions will pay Historic Rally Club Finland 5,00 € for each pair of competitors entitled to start (including additional classes). Historic Rally Club Finland will use this income to cover series promotion and other expenses.

6. Technical scrutineering and inspection

ASN (AKK-Motorsport) nominates the Chief of Scrutineering for the series.

The eligibility of cars will be inspected during the series period, through pre-event scrutineering and possible post-rally technical inspections.

7. Points and scoring

If there is only one (1) competitor in a class, that competitor will receive nine (9) points, for being in the final results of the competition.

8. Participation points

Each competitor will receive additional points according to how many rallies in the series she/he has participated, as an approved competitor in the relevant category. From the competitor's first rally, she/he earns one (1) extra point, from the next rally two (2), from the third rally three (3) and from the fourth rally four (4).

A competitor can earn extra points for a maximum of four competitions. If there are less than six competitions, the number of competitions entitling to additional points will be reduced accordingly.

Participation points are not taken into account in the HRT overall series standings.

9. Final points in series

Four (4) best rallies of each competitor will be considered for the final points of the series. If there are less than six (6) rallies in the series, the amount -2 will be taken into account in the end points.

If a competitor's performance is rejected in a series of rallies, due to non-compliance with the technical regulations of the car found during the technical inspection, that rally will be counted as one of the rallies to be included in scoring.

In the event of a tie, the highest single point scoring will decide; then the second highest, etc. If this does not bring the solution to the ranking, the competitor in which class has had more competitors totally in her/his class and category, will have higher ranking. If these amounts are also even, the competitors split the ranking.

10. Starting order

Historic Rally Club Finland prepares the starting order of the rallies.

11. Advertisements

Historic Rally Club Finland reserves the right to the following advertising spaces for competitors' cars:

- advertising space at the top of the windshield
- 20 cm x 40 cm advertising space on the front doors

12. Prizing

ASN (AKK-Motorsport) will award the winners of the Historic Rally Trophy categories.

Historic Rally Club Finland will award:

- Historic Rally Trophy series final points: five (5) top drivers and co-drivers in each category
- Historic Rally Trophy series overall competition; five (5) top drivers
- Reconnaissance Class, Classic F and Historic Regularity Rally series; three (3) top drivers and co-drivers
